## Violation of Right to Peaceful Assembly

### Four Demonstrators Shot Dead

***There has been widespread demonstrations in different parts of the capital on the 14th day of the movement continued by the seven political parties demanding full democracy in the country.***

At least four demonstrators have been killed as RNA and APF men opened fire on a massive rally of seven political parties at Chandragadhi, Jhapa on April 19. Rajendra Giri of Arjundhara VDC of Jhapa and Suraj Bishwas of Bharatpur Municipality of Jhapa were identified whereas two dead bodies were taken by the RNA. Over 2 hundred demonstrators have been reported to be injured. A Fact-finding team, in the leadership of INSEC Eastern Regional Office, Biratnagar is investigating at the incident place on April 20.

In Singhdurbar, staffs of the Radio Nepal have protested in the support of democratic movement in the office premises from 2 am to 12.30 pm on 19th April. Biswa Khanal photo journalist has been arrested by armed police for taking photo of the protest program of radio Nepal's staffs. Armed police vehicle is stand by, by the side of the radio Nepal office. Similarly in the mid day today protest program were held at Nepal Television and Nepal Film Development board for the democracy.

Officials from other government office whose office is not located in the premised of the Singhdurbar has been barred from entering the Singhdurbar with the order from home ministry due increasing protest for democracy day by day.

In Baneswor campus at Baneswor; Morang - Kathmandu Contact Forum organized a tea program and well wishing ceremony on the occasion of the new year expressing solidarity with democratic movement. CPN UML Bharat Mohan Adhikari kept his views in the well wishing ceremony and tea program. After wrapping up the protest procession program. That procession ended in the corner meeting after reaching Madhya Baneswor from Baneswor Campus. Addressing the corner meeting, E x - chairman of Nepal Student Association, Gururaj Ghimire invited all for the participant in tomorrow's demonstration to be organized in the programme. Program has been organized with out any intervention of the security forces.

At Kalanki there was demonstration since today morning. The protest procession from Thankot to Kalanki has been barred from entering the Ring Road. Demonstrators have been there in seat-in program enchanting the anti king slogans.

At Thahachal, police arrested B Ed first year student Krishna Khanal at 12 am from Mahendra Ratna Campus. Khanal was arrested when he was participating in the Mask Rally in the front of campus.

General Secretary of CPN UML Madhav Kumar Nepal was released on April 19, after four months. He was kept under house internment from January 19 and was detained in APF training centre Kakani from March 23.
